Annual Meeting of Shareholders

On September 15, 2015, Federated National Holding Company (the "Company") held its annual meeting of shareholders. A total of 12,747,822 of the Company's outstanding shares of common stock, representing approximately 89.6% of the shares eligible to vote, were present or represented by proxy at the annual meeting. The following two proposals were voted on at the annual meeting, and each was approved by the Company's shareholders with the necessary number of votes required by the Company's charter documents and applicable corporate law:

1. The election of Richard W. Wilcox, Jr. as Class II director to serve until the annual meeting of shareholders to be held in 2018 or until his successor is elected and qualified; and
2. To ratify the appointment of Ernst & Young LLP as the Company's independent registered public accounting firm for the 2015 fiscal year.
